

Conclusions

- ◆ Focus for Demonstration project concerned source investigations & High Visibility Enforcement
- ◆ Implementation followed model so HVE approach holds significant promise
- ◆ Training (i.e. *Source Investigation, Media 101*) was essential to building capacity for follow through on underage drinking cases
- ◆ This was a great opportunity because officer focus was on alcohol sources & not just youth consuming alcohol
- ◆ Use of data to assess, plan, implement, & evaluate strategies is extremely important
