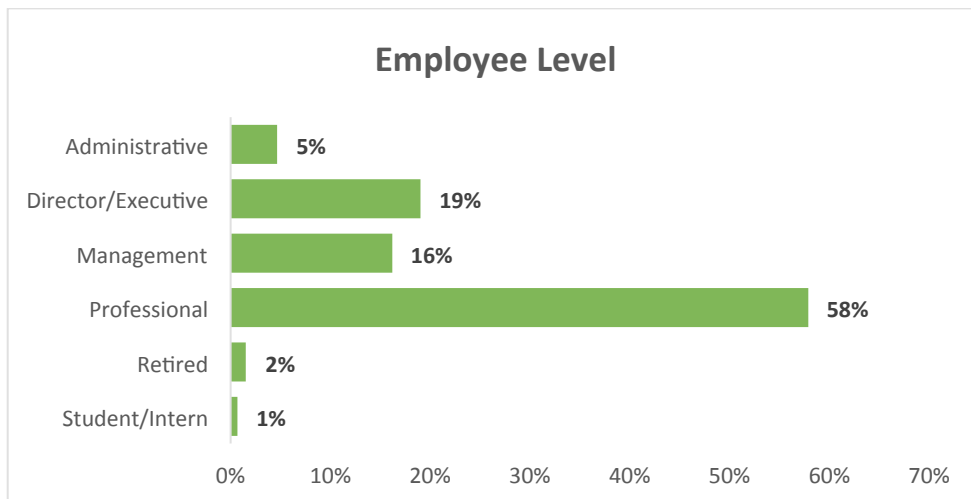
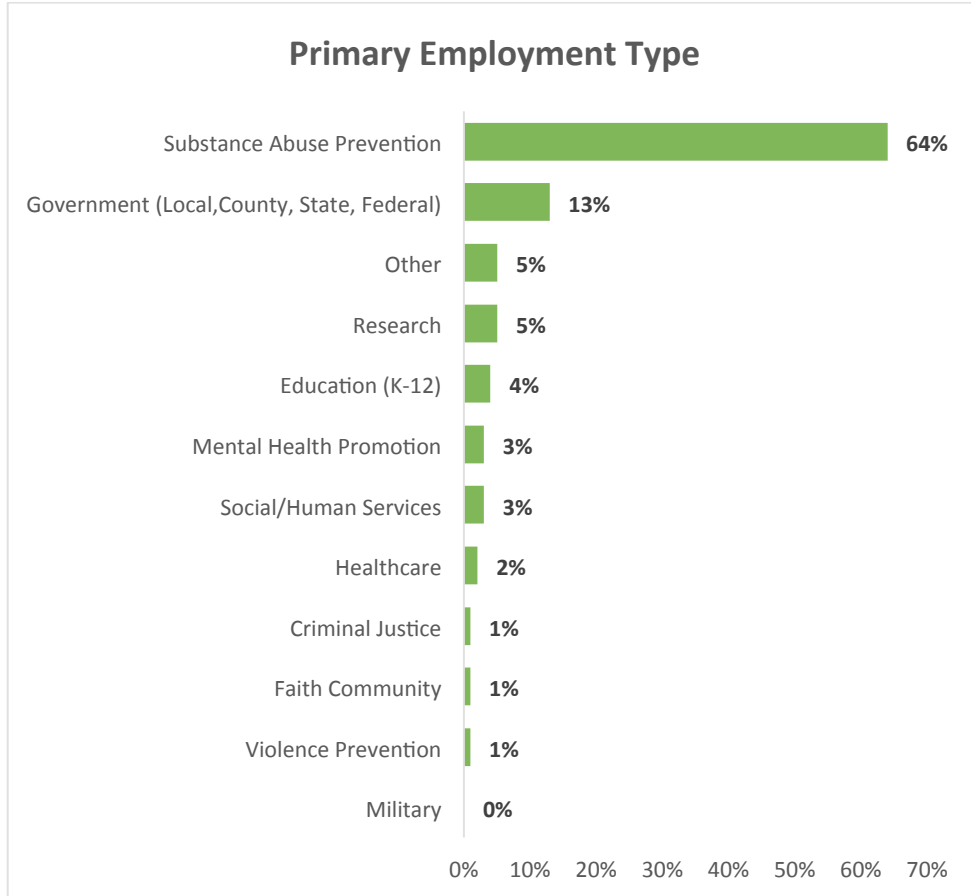

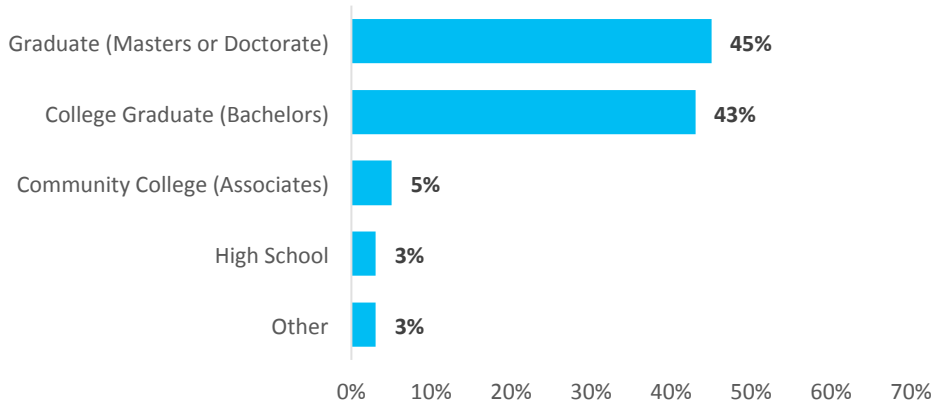
## Registration Data

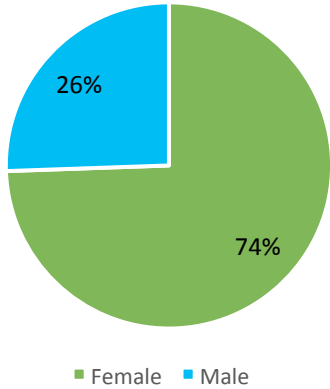

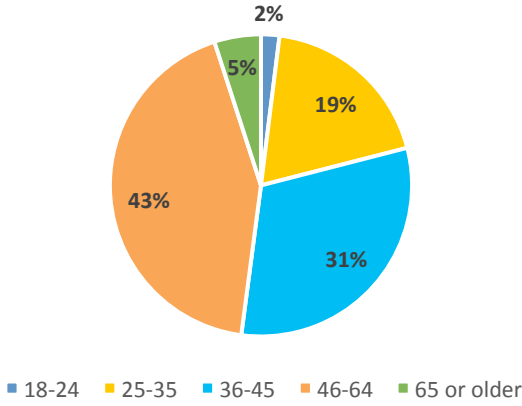
### Education Level



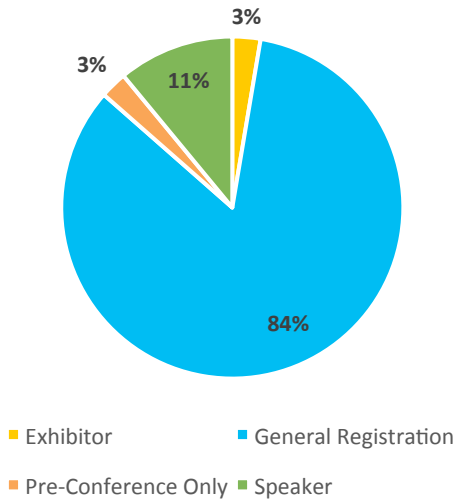

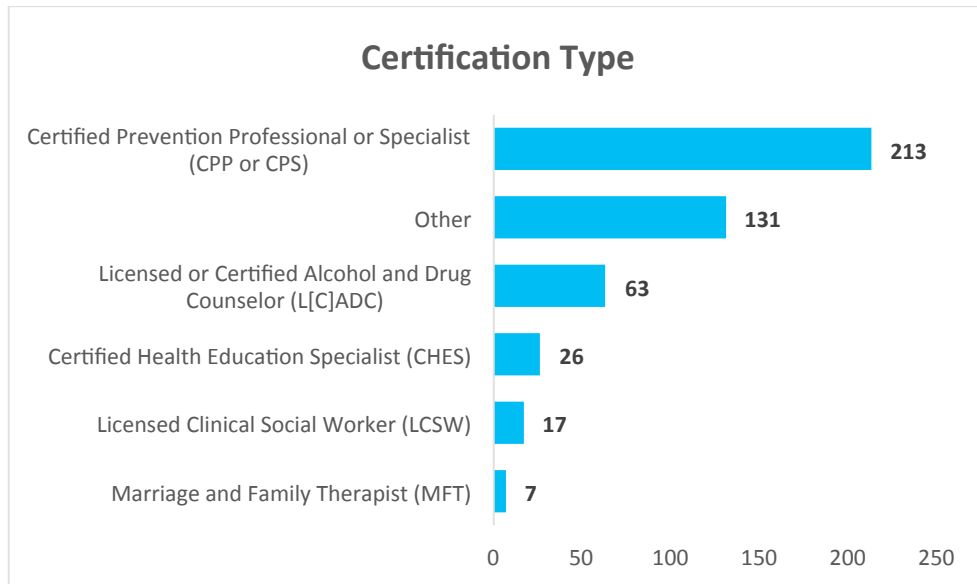
