#### **∞** Research

 Informs theory and overall practice – You need research in order to identify the appropriate data sets and to provide evidence that certain strategies will change the data so the data and strategies and be organized for assessment and evaluation.

#### **SO** Assessment

 Includes efforts to gather analyze and interpret evidence -- You must analyze the data sets and formulate hypothesis for interpreting evidence that changes may happen when utilizing appropriate strategies.

#### **∞** Evaluation

Involves methods and analysis that answer questions to inform programmatic improvement – You
must continually test and measure the data in order to determine if the strategies chosen are actually
working.
