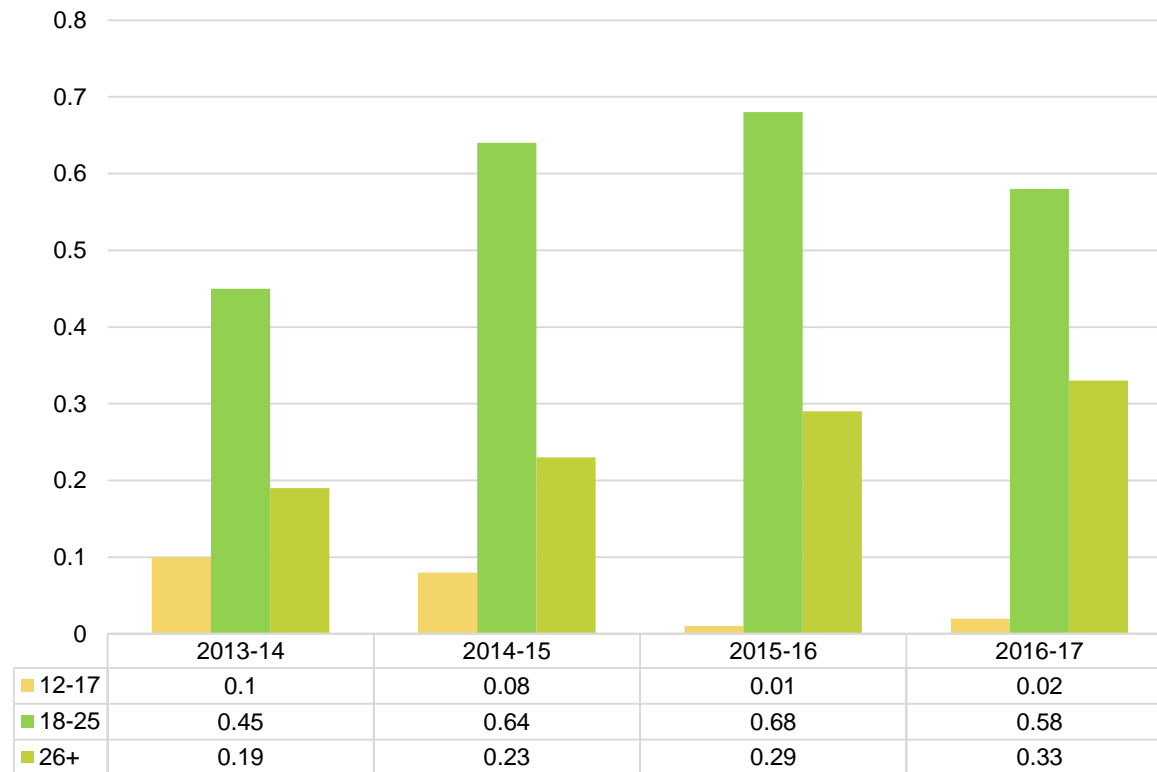
Helen Keller

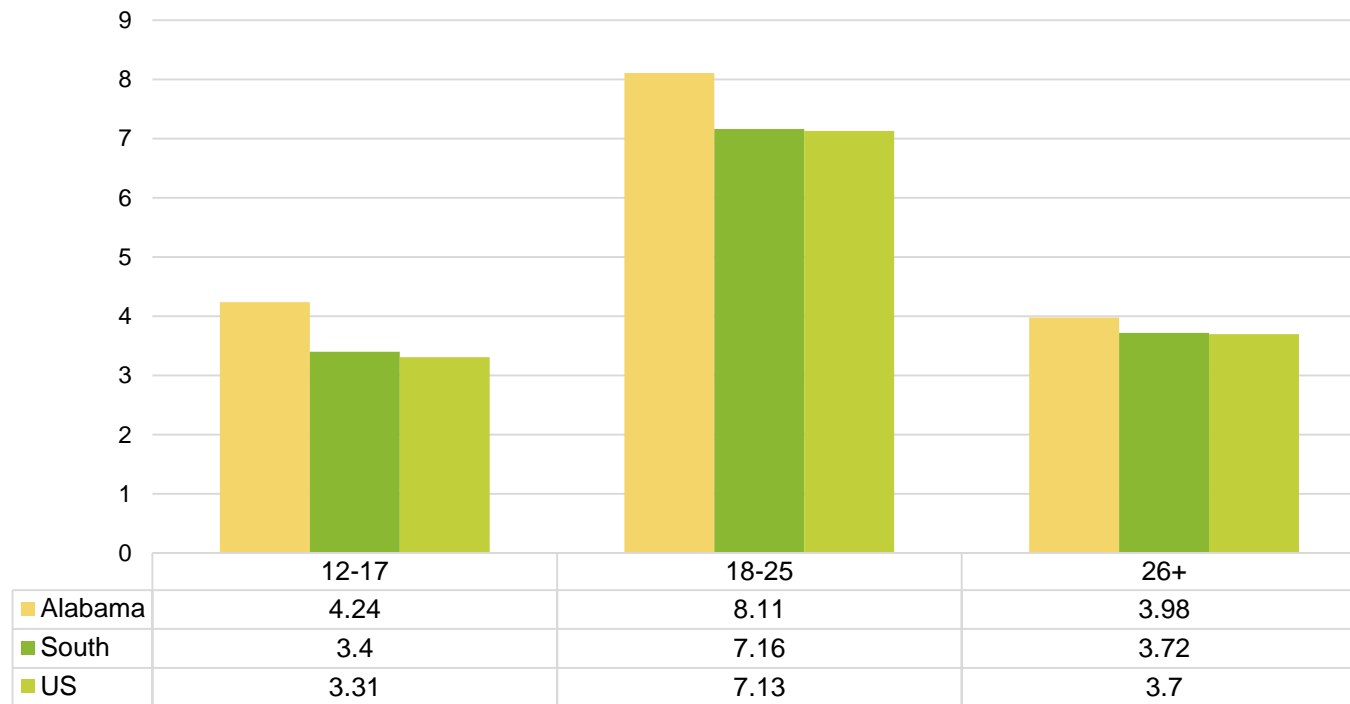
Figure 32 - Heroin Use in the Past Month by Age Groups & Year,%

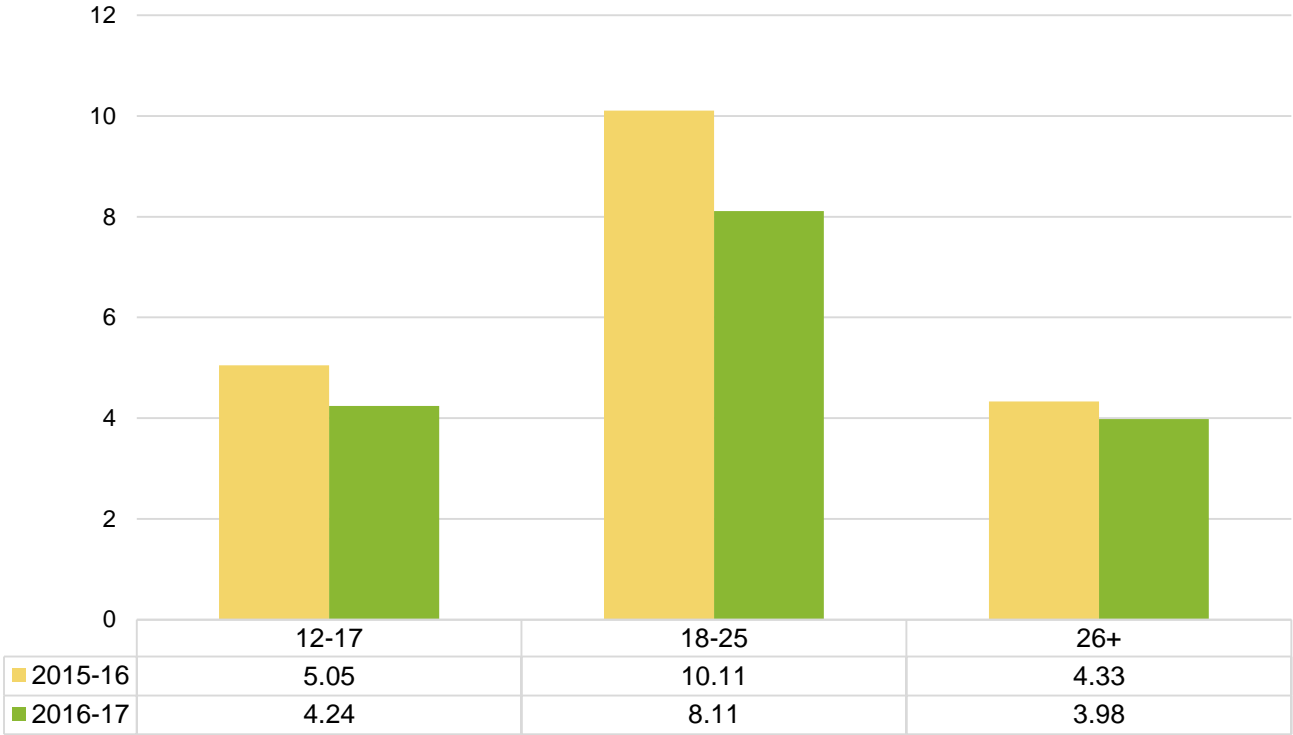
Figure 32 - Pain Reliever Misuse in the Past Year by Age Group, 2016-2017,%

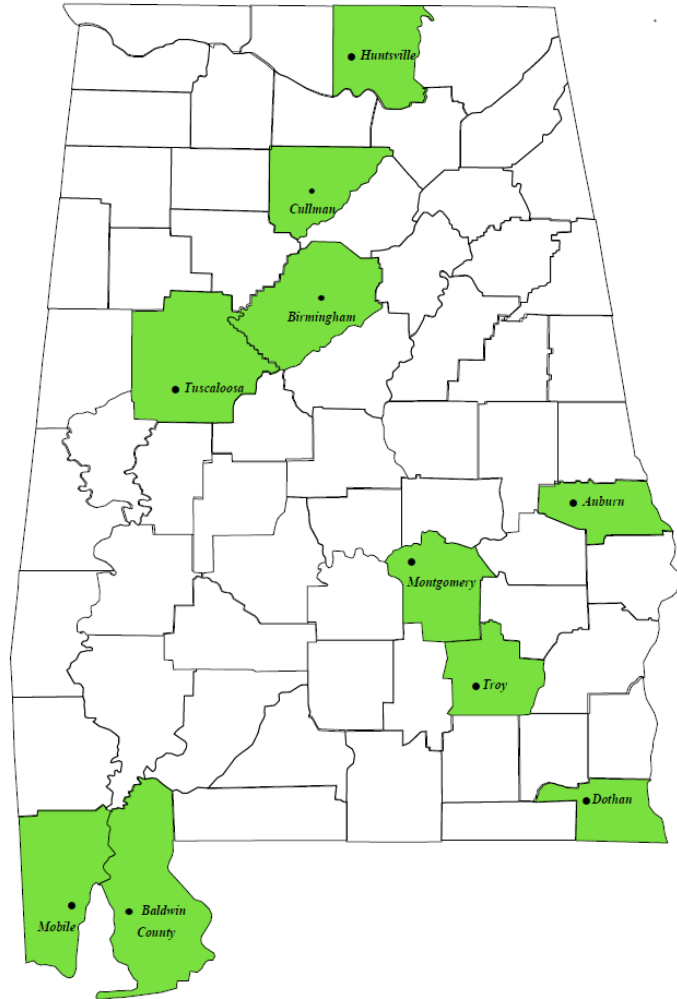
