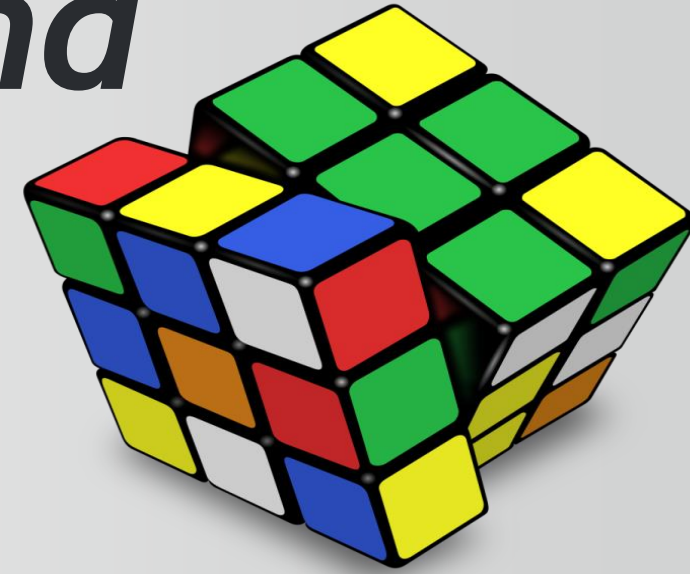
Today-Prevention Work-force

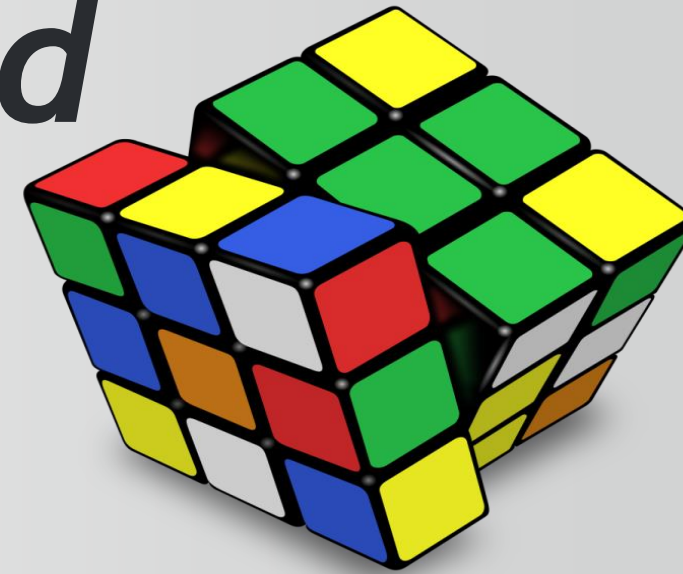


- *Training Needs Assessment*
