

MEDICATION REVIEW PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Enroll individuals 18 and older in our medication review program

Pharmacy review participant's medication, identify dangerous side effects, dangerous drug-to-drug interactions, and drug sensitivities

Participants are notified of pharmacy findings

Enroll individuals into specific Evidence-based program according to their age and specific need

Encourage participants to follow primary physician

Follow up with participants 3 and 6 months
